

Supplies for Lopatcong Students 2017-2018

Please put the child's name on bags and clothing.

Please replenish supplies throughout the year!

Preschool

1 bookbag (must be big enough to fit a folder and snack)

1 lunchbox/bag

2 folders

An extra set of clothes, (underwear, shirt, pants, socks) in a plastic bag, with name clearly marked on the outside of the bag.

Kindergarten

Backpack: big enough to hold folder and other belongings

1 sturdy pocket folder – clearly labeled with the child's name

Reusable snack bag – clearly labeled with the child's name

1 pack of 24 count crayons

1 pack washable markers

2 glue sticks

An extra set of clothes to keep in the backpack for emergencies.

All 4th Grades

1. 2" three ring binder
2. 6 pocket folders that are 3-hole punched (no metal prongs)
3. 2 pocket folders (no 3-hole punch necessary)
4. 2 wo-subject notebooks
5. 1 composition book
6. Three-ring zipper pencil pouch
7. one hard pencil box (to store extra supplies in your cubby; this is not meant to travel with you from class to class)
8. Dry erase markers
9. Small washcloth (no eraser for dry erase markers)
10. Highlighters (multiple colors)
11. Pens (multiple colors)
12. Pencils
13. Erasers
14. Headphones or earbuds in a zip lock bag with name clearly written on it

Items are to be stored in the zipper pencil pouch. Therefore, it is important to check that those items will fit before coming to school with them. The zipper pencil pouch is also meant to travel with you from class to class. This will ensure that you will have the proper supplies for each class as you will be going to different rooms for different subjects.
