## Lopatcong Township School District Preschool Inclusion Program School Year: 2019-2020

To Parents of Preschool Age Children:

The Lopatcong Township School District is currently accepting applications for its three and four year old Preschool Inclusion Program for the 2019-2020 school year.

To be considered for the Preschool Inclusion Program, the pupil must be a Lopatcong resident, three years old before October 1, 2019, and s/he must be completely toilet trained.

The 2019-2020 tuition rate will be \$3,000, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$300 each.

Along with the program application, there is \$25.00 registration fee. (Checks made payable to Lopatcong Township School District) Please complete the application packet and return it to the elementary school with the \$25.00 registration fee by Friday, April 5, 2019. Due to the number of requests, a lottery drawing will be held on Friday, April 26, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. in the CST conference room in the Middle School. Parents are welcome to attend the lottery, but your attendance is not mandatory for your child to be selected.

Parents will be notified in writing by May 3, 2019.

If your child is not selected through the lottery, the registration fee will be returned to you and your child's name will be placed on the wait list in the event of an opening.
