- Meets at least once annually with case manager, parents and other professional staff to review and revise the individualized education program (IEP) and placement of each assigned pupil.
- Communicates with parents through conferences and other means to inform them about the school program and to discuss pupil progress.
- Follows the specifics of the IEP regarding pupil progress reporting, including but not limited to completion of quarterly progress reports addressing IEP goals and objectives.
- Maintains professional competence and continuous improvement through in-service education and other professional growth activities.
- Participates in school-level planning, faculty meetings/committees, and other school system groups.
- Makes effective use of community resources to enhance the educational program.
- Upholds and enforces school rules, administrative regulations, and board policy.
- Ability to implement an intensive, systematic individualized program which focuses on engaging the students at their developmental level
